2. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Site Plan (minimum 11" x 17") showing the existing wetlands and the proposed limits of disturbance, grading, and erosion and sedimentation control measures. Visit the Engineering Division Maps & Records Office to obtain the best available mapping.
- GIS Conversion Fee. The developer/owner of any project receiving land use approval within the Town of Manchester may be required to submit a fee to cover digital GIS conversion costs incurred by the Town.
- A completed DEEP Reporting form (available online at http://www.ct.gov/deep/lib/deep/water_inland/wetlands/siwwarf.pdf or in the Planning Department).
- Seven (7) complete sets of application packet (i.e. application, site plan, and any other attachments).
- A Filing Fee of \$135.00.
