

ARTICLE I

GENERAL

Section 5

PUBLIC HEARING NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS¹

5.00 For all applications and appeals requiring public hearings of the Planning and Zoning Commission and/or the Zoning Board of Appeals, the applicant or appellant shall be responsible for posting a sign or signs on the subject property notifying the public of any scheduled public hearing.

The sign will be provided by the Planning Department. The sign posting shall comply with the following:

- (a) Sign(s) shall be placed on the property that is the subject of the public hearing (NOTE: the sign may not be placed within the public right-of-way between the curb or edge of pavement and the front property line);
- (b) All signs shall be located so that its message is clearly visible and legible from each street abutting the subject property;
- (c) Sign(s) shall be posted for at least ten days prior to the public hearing;
- (d) Prior to commencement of the public hearing, the applicant shall submit evidence that the sign was posted as required above.
